Details of the Scheme

Nomenclature of Medal: Main "	(Donor's name) Scholastic Medal for
(Course or Discipline)"	

Medal Description: Round Medal of 35-40 g. 100% Silver.

Medal Design will include suitably: (i) Image of Donor/ Logo of CDPMM; (ii) Name of CDPMM in full (Shree Chargam Dasha Porwad Mahamandal); (iii) Name of the Awardee (First name, Initial of father's name or Second name and Surname); (iv) Degree/ Course for which medal awarded; (v) Date of Award. Medal design to be approved by Medal Committee.

<u>Award</u>: One medal to be awarded to the person with best overall performance in the specified discipline or course during the year October-September. Medal Committee shall decide high minimum performance levels for eligibility and appropriate criteria and methodology to arrive at the decision of best performance. Rules, eligibility, methodology and criteria shall be clearly spelt out in writing to avoid any unambiguity and to ensure objectivity in the decision.

<u>Presentation</u>: To be presented in Maha-Adhiveshan individually for each year. (As Maha-Adhiveshan will held once in two/ three years, more medals may be awarded, one for each year, subject to candidates' eligibility.

Courses: Minimum 4 years course after H. S. C. (10+2)

- Engineering / Technical: Mech., Elect., Chem., Civil, etc. (Non-I. T., Non-Life Sciences)
- Engineering/ Technical: I.T. and Computer Engg.; Computer Application; Other
- Medical Medicine and Surgery *
- Medical Other (Dentistry; Physio-Therapy; other Check whether separately for Physio-Therapy, Dentistry or other)
- Pharmacy, Bio-medical, etc. (Life Sciences)
- Para-medical (subject to min. 4 years mandatory after HSC i.e. 10+2)
- M. B. A.
- C. A.
- I. C. W. A., C. S., C. F. A., etc. Check whether separately for each discipline.
- Law (subject to min. 4 years mandatory after HSC i.e. 10+2)**
- Post-graduate degrees in Arts, Science, Commerce, Other Humanities

Minimum 2 additional years after above courses

Post-Graduates in Professional Courses and Doctorates in all courses

<u>Fund</u>: Min. Rs. 60,000 per Medal of 35-40 g. Fund value is related to the price of silver. It is arrived at in such a manner that medal making cost will be approximately 50-60% of annual interest, and balance interest will be capitalised towards the fund to take care of inflation partly. (Supplementary Fund may be required to be added periodically by the donor, depending upon fund value and price of silver from time to time.)

Die Cost: Donor to bear.

<u>Medal Committee</u>: President, Secretary, Donor (one representative), Other MC Member, External Expert.
